

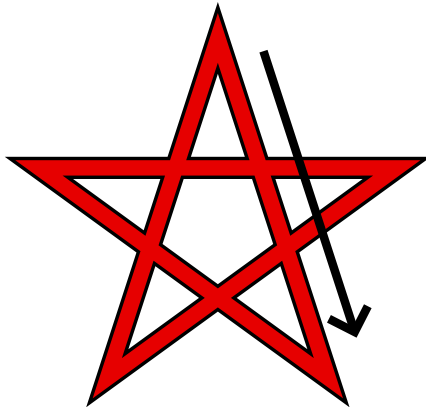
# The Element of Fire

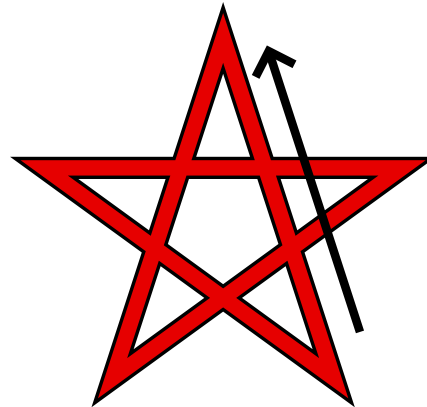

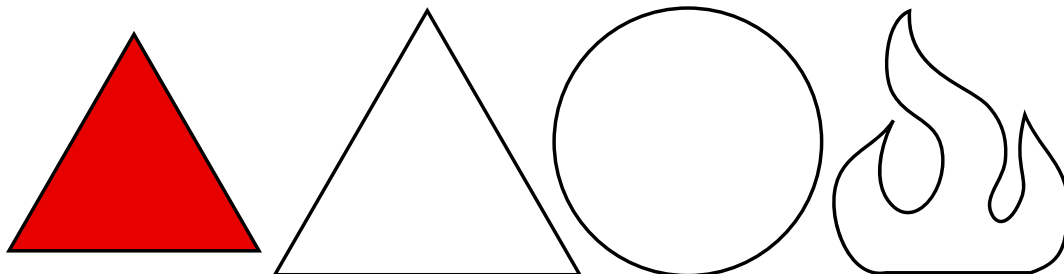
**Fire Invoking Pentagram**

### Fire Incense

3 parts frankincense  
 2 parts dragons blood  
 1 part red sandalwood  
 1 pinch saffron  
 A few drops of musk oil

### Fire Oil

3 drops ginger  
 2 drops rosemary  
 1 clove  
 1/8 cup base oil
